Appendix 1: Special terms and conditions of trade in young plants

Danish Plant Varieties Act and deadlines for submission of complaints regarding 'rooted young plants' and 'unrooted cuttings'

It should be noted that, under the Danish Plant Varieties Act (*Lov om plantenyheder*), varieties subject to a licence requirement may be propagated only if the buyer has concluded a valid licence agreement with the rights holder.

Deadlines for submission of complaints regarding young plants:

- The deadline for submission of complaints regarding 'rooted young plants' is 96 hours from the time of delivery to the buyer. However, a deadline for submission of complaints of 14 days is applicable in cases where the cause of the complaint is pest infestation which was present in the product at the time of delivery.

The deadline for submission of complaints regarding 'unrooted cuttings' is 96 hours after rooting, with Sundays and public holidays being included in the calculation of the deadline. However, the deadline for submission of complaints is extended to when rooting has taken place (visible roots) in cases where the cause of the complaint is pest infestation which was present in the product at the time of delivery.
